Whether you need to complete credit for a failed course or want to focus your efforts in a particular subject, Catholic Memorial School in West Roxbury offers courses to meet your needs. Students currently in grades 8-12 can choose from classes in math (algebra and geometry), English, theology, history (US and world), the sciences (physical science, chemistry, and biology), Spanish, French, Latin, and Italian. All courses, sessions, and costs are subject to change depending on enrollment. Mail in your registration or register on-site at the school. Full payment is expected at time of registration. ### About CM Summer Education

CM Summer School runs for three weeks, from 6 -28 July 2011. Classes meet daily and students can enroll in up to two classes. The first class runs from 7:45am to 9:45am; the second class from 10:00am to noon. Each session meets the relevant Mass. Dept. of Education guidelines. Cost for each class, including texts and registration fees, is \$450.

For students who enroll in courses for enrichment, the cost is reduced to \$350. While students are expected to participate in class and stay current with all assignments, grades are not recorded and transcripts are not sent to the student's school.

## NEW COURSE OFFERING! Preparing the research paper and the college essay.

To help ensure comfort and success in generating engaging essays, CM will offer an **Essay Writing course**. This dynamic session will meet **Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, 6-8 July 2011 from 8:30 to 10:30am and then again each Wednesday in July (13, 20, and 27) from 8:30 to 10:30am to review and refine projects and assignments.**

**Students will be in contact with the instructor between sessions to review their work. Current sophomores will research and prepare a solid essay on an issue of interest to them. Current juniors will prepare their college essay and will be able to use the piece for admission to colleges in the fall. The cost for the essay writing course is \$250.**
